

Important Public Hearings – Millcreek

Incorporation Feasibility Study

In January, Salt Lake County received a petition to begin the incorporation feasibility study process for the Millcreek Township, including the communities of Canyon Rim, East Mill Creek, Millcreek, and Mt. Olympus. In accordance with state law, the petition set in motion an extensive process of public involvement to allow the landowners and voters in the Millcreek Township to determine the future of governance for their community.

A consultant, Lewis, Young, Robertson & Burningham, was selected to conduct the required feasibility study. The information presented in the study findings will help Salt Lake County and Millcreek Township residents to better understand the viability of Millcreek forming its own city and the impact such a move would have on the remaining townships.

The feasibility study will be accepted by the County Council on June 7. The County Council will be hosting two public hearings to discuss the findings of the feasibility study. Other elected officials, including Mayor Peter Corroon, will also be in attendance for these hearings. All residents are invited to attend.
